related to registration for SpringerNature Workshop

This Privacy Policy aims at drawing your attention to our data processing operations encountered during the registration for SpringerNature Workshop.

1. Contact Details

The Data Controller responsible for data processing operations encountered during the registration for SpringerNature Workshop is the University of Szeged, but the specific data processing is conducted by the following body:

2. Legal Requirements

We inform you that the University of Szeged as Data Controller conducts the processing of your data according to the following requirements:

- ⌚ to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and on Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on repealing Directive 95/46/EC, and
- ⌚ to Act 112 of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and on Freedom of Information.

4. Data Processing During the Event

The following data processing activities are carried out during the registration for SpringerNature Workshop – 1. Registration, 2. Taking photos

4.1. Registration

Name of the registrant	It will depend on the number of individual registrants whether the Workshop is held by the organizer or not; therefore, these data are used for estimating the potential number of participants.	'Consent' of the data subject means any freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the data subject's wishes by which he or she, by a statement or by a clear affirmative action, signifies agreement to the processing of personal data relating to him or her.	Data are stored until the end of the Workshop. The data subject shall have the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
E-mail address of the registrant	It is required for the identification of individual participants and for maintaining contact.		
Parent institution of the registrant	The Workshop will be customized according to the specific disciplinary preferences of the audience.		

4.2. Taking Photos

We inform you that photos will be taken during the Workshop, mainly of the crowd. We would like to highlight that the event is open for the public media.

According to Section 2:48 Article (2) of Act 5 of 2013 on the Civil Code, the consent of the relevant person is not required for taking photos of a crowd or in a public event and for using them. However, previous information should be given in these cases, so we fulfill the preliminary notification obligation to inform data subjects through this Privacy Policy, and through information provided at the event stating "We would like to inform you that photos will be taken during this event".

As the University of Szeged is dedicated to the protection and safety of all kinds of personal data, and the respect of privacy, we inform you that we use the photos of a crowd in a public event to promote the event and for marketing purposes through the online and offline channels of the University of Szeged.

5. Transmitting Data

During the registration for the SpringerNature Workshop and the processing of the data involved, no action is taken in transmitting data neither inland nor abroad.

Your data will be processed by employees assigned by the manager of the data processing body specified in Section 1 with the purpose, within the legal basis and data storage period specified in Section 4.

6. Data Processing from Third Parties

We do not process personal data from third parties. Your personal data will be provided based on your voluntary consent and not from other sources.

7. Automated Decision-making

No automated decision-making happens in the course of the data processing.

8. Data Subject Rights

We inform you about your rights in connection with the registration for the SpringerNature Workshop:

1. right to information – you have the right to ask for information on the processing of your personal data.
2. right of access by the data subject – you have access to your personal data we process.
3. right to rectification – should you find inaccuracies in your personal data processed by us, you have the right to ask for rectification.
4. right to erasure – if there is no other legal basis for data processing, you can ask for the erasure of your personal data.
5. right to object – you have the right to object against data processing based on legitimate interest at any time.
6. right to restriction of processing – you have the right to ask for the restriction of the processing of your personal data, for example, after you find inaccuracies in your personal data, you can ask for restriction of processing while the University of Szeged keeps checking the accuracy of data.
7. right to data portability – in automated data processing, if data processing is based on your voluntary consent, and you need your personal data, your personal data processed by us is given to you.
8. right to legal remedy – every data subject has the right to legal remedy in case of an infringement.
